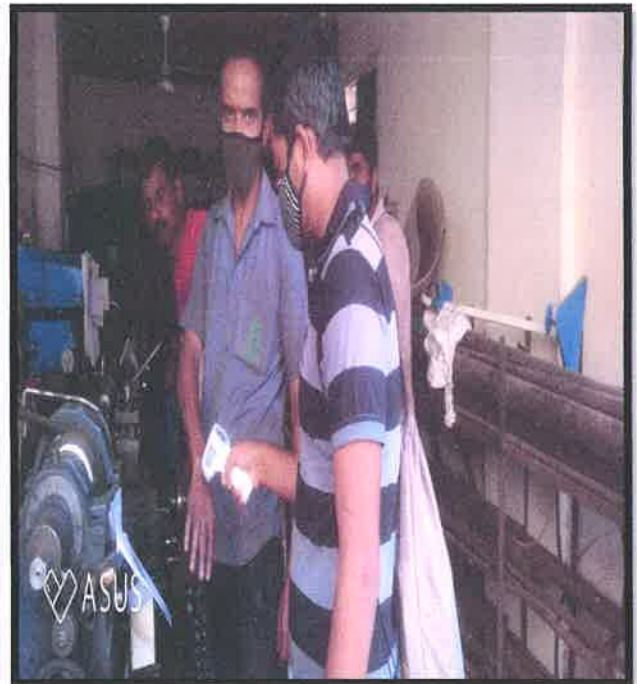
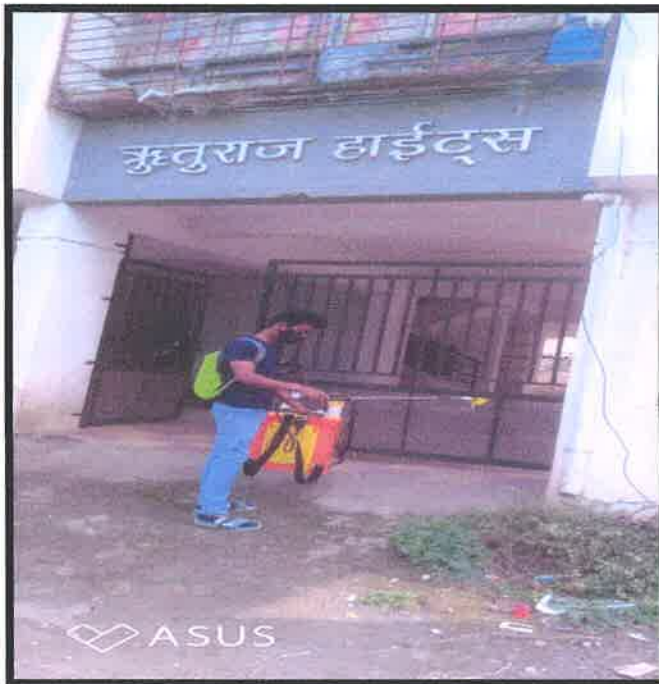

**Groceries Distribution**

**Date: 21st March 2021**

The NSS (National Service Scheme) Unit of the Asian College of Science and Commerce located in Dhayari, Pune-41 is dedicated to serving the people in the local community. On 21st March 2021, the adopted villages of Rule and Donje, with a combined population of around 6000 people.

These two villages require development, with a significant proportion of the population struggling to make ends meet. Unfortunately, the COVID-19 lockdown has only made things worse. Although the government is making efforts to provide food, it is not enough to meet the needs of all the people.

In light of this, the NSS Unit decided to take action. They identified needy families through the Village Representative Mr. Shankarrao Ranvade Sarpanch of Rule Village and Sarpanch of Donje Village. Faculty members and students appealed to donate voluntarily for this purpose, and the response was overwhelming.

The NSS Unit made food packets that contained 5kg of Tur dal, 5kg of Moong dal, 5kg of Chana Dal, 5-liter Oil packet, 1kg salt packet, 5kg onion, 2kg potato, 10 soaps, toothpaste, etc. These packets were carefully put together and distributed to over 100 families in both villages.
